What we have done...

P1

In P1 we have looked at the different names for fruits and vegetable and designed our very own healthy lunchbox. We have presented the food that we like and don't like and taken part in a role-play in small groups called In the Restaurant. We are now working on the City and Shops topic. We have listened to stories, designed our own shop and taken part in team vocabulary games.

P2

In P2 we have been investigating lots of sports, the usual ones and not so usual. We then made posters about our favourite sport and a leaflet to describe a sport in as much detail as we could. We are very proud of how they turned out. We have now begun to look at the topic City and Shops. We have taken part in speaking activities, worked with partners and designed our own city or town.

P3

In P3 we have been looking at the topic At the Doctor's. We worked in pairs to learn a doctor and patient role play. We then presented it for the rest of the class. We filmed our presentations and really enjoyed watching them on the interactive whiteboard. Some made us laugh! We have also learnt lots of new vocabulary for describing illnesses and how we are feeling. We found some words difficult to pronounce, like earache and cough!

P4


In our L2 class this period, students became art critics and artists. First we explored our responses to art, famous artists and some famous images. Each class then focused on a different artist, Piet Mondrian, Salvador Dali and Andy Warhol. We then presented our findings using posters and paintings to other L2 classes. We then moved onto the topic At the Doctor's, expanding our vocabulary about the human body, investigation body part names, what can go wrong with it and how we can keep our bodies healthy. It was great to see the meaning of words such as ankle, heel, stretcher, bruise and sprain become clearer.

P5

In P5 we have just completed our Pupils and the World Around Them topic. Through this topic we explored Australia in detail. We researched and wrote about some of the amazing animals that live there, planned a trip around the country, visiting lots of different famous landmarks and we went on the very first L2 English trip to the Aboriginal Art museum in Utrecht! When we returned from this trip we wrote a recount of our visit.
